With the Department of Defence instituting a new way to organise the delivery of naval maintenance in Australia, our team helped embed an enduring collaborative working culture between diverse elements of industry and Defence in an integrated matrixed organisation.

This involved:



Incorporating a Collaborative Working business operating model design and implementation methodology in to the design of the new Regional Maintenance Centres (RMCs).



Supporting the development of a tailored Joint Relationship Management Plan (JRMP) for the parties in each RMC enterprise.



Incorporating the JRMPs in to an RMC Network wide business management system to standardise and enable collaboration.

The benefits are being realised. As of August 2024, all four RMCs have been established as well as a business unit for the central coordination and management of the RMC Network, with business relationships being managed through the business management system and the associated JRMPs.
